Nora Tsoukala graduated from the Department of Speech Pathology at the Flinders University of South Australia in 2001. Her studies and clinical experience have been accredited by Speech Pathology Australia, the British Council of Professions Supplementary to Medicine, the Royal College of Speech and Language Therapists and the Panhellenic Association of Logopaedists. She has worked in the public sector in Australia, the United Kingdom, and Greece, where she has also been a clinical associate at HYGEIA hospital, KAT hospital and the Developmental and Behavioural Paediatrics Unit at "Agia Sofia" Children's Hospital, as well as a clinical supervisor of speech therapy students of the TEI of Patras.

At URI she coordinates and secretarially supports the programme "Multidisciplinary Clinic for Clinical Research in Developmental and Behavioural Paediatrics", headed by Dr P. Pervanidou, since 2019. In the private sector, as a Speech Pathologist, she offers assessment, diagnosis and therapy services to children with fluency disorders (e.g., stuttering), neurogenic speech and language disorders, general developmental delay (e.g., due to premature birth or low birth weight) and oro-motor difficulties.
