Athanasios Michos is Associate Professor of Pediatrics and Infectious Diseases at the First Department of Pediatrics, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens and he is responsible for the Infectious Diseases Laboratory at Choremeion Research Laboratory. He was trained in Pediatric Infectious Diseases at Children’s Hospital, Boston, USA and in epidemiology and biostatistics at Harvard School of Public Health. During these years he studied the pathogenesis of *S.pyogenes* in human infections. Currently he is working on the molecular epidemiology of pathogens including bacteria (*S.pyogenes*, *S.pneumoniae*), fungi (Candida and rare fungi) and viruses (Rotavirus, Enterovirus, Parechovirus, SARS-CoV-2). He is also working on the immune response to pathogens and their association with the clinical manifestations.
