Dr Geronikolou is a licensed Public and Environmental Hygienist and Inspector, further educated in Environmental Management in Turin Italy with an EU scholarship. Her international license on Hazard analysis Critical Control Points (Food/waterborne infections and allergies prevention -design focus) was awarded by the Royal Society of Public Health and Hull University of London. She has obtained a MSc degree on Biomedicine by the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens Medical School and Biology Dpt, and her PhD degree by the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens Medical School under the supervision of Prof C Kanaka-Gantenbein. Her Post-doc Research work has been performed under the instructions of Prof G Chrousos and Prof D Cokkinos in the Biomedical Research Foundation of the Academy of Athens Clinical Dpt.

From 1995 to 2008 she was a collaborating researcher in Research Center of Astronomy and Applied Mathematics in the Academy of Athens. Since 2009 she is a collaborating researcher in the Clinical Translational and Experimental Surgery Research Center of the Biomedical Research Foundation of the Academy of Athens and the First Dpt of Pediatrics “Aghia Sophia Hospital”, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens Medical School. Since 2013 she also collaborates to UNESCO Chair Adolescent Health of the latter Dpt, since 2016 to the First Propedeutic Clinic of Surgery -Hippokrateion Hospital, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens Medical School and since 2020 with the Ag Savvas Oncology Hospital.

She has 6 International conventions (co-President in 2 of them), she has founded and headed in a Non-Profit Society of Public Health (Efporista 2010-2013), and served as director in the International School of Civilization “Thrace Tamieion” in Kastelorizo island in 2005.

She is member of MEDECC network (Mediterranean Experts on Climate and Environmental Change) since 2016, while she served as reviewer of the 1<sup>st</sup> Mediterranean Assessment Report (MAR1) developed by the network of Mediterranean Experts on Climate and Environmental Change (MedECC).

She is Editor in 3 international peer reviewed journals and reviewer in 15. She is member in 10 (5 Greek and 5 International) Scientific Societies (in 2 of which she has been elected as Treasurer).

She is a professional translator and interpreter in five languages, and a trained paleographer: she has translated 3 medical books- among which the oldest known Arabic medical manuscript. She is author of 15 books, 13 chapters in books, 31 research articles in international peer reviewed

journals, 2 articles in Greek peer reviewed journals. One of her works has been included in the Academy of Athens Publications, while she has more than 150 presentations in National and International Conferences.

Her research work focuses on History of Medicine, Public Environmental Electromagnetic Health, Epigenetics, Physiology, Epidemiology, Systems and Precision science.
